In horses and ponies that only have moderate exercise (1 to 3 hours a week), overeating is more likely than malnutrition. The energy and protein intake must be limited as must be the starch supply to prevent laminitis. A sufficient supply of fibres (cellulose) must be provided and the ration must be supplied in a small volume so as not to overload the stomach.

- ⊗ Methionine + Cystine : 3,7 g
- ⊗ Total zinc : 180 ppm included 54 ppm chelated form
- ⊗ Biotin : supply of 11 mg per day with 2.2 kg of **loisir/leisure**

Rations

2 or 3 meals per day for horses weighting 500 kg or ponies weighting 250 kg.

- ∞ Unlimited clean water
- ∞ If your horse has just started **loisir/leisure**, mix it in gradually with the previous feed.

- ∞ Density : about 450 g/litre
- ∞ Store in a cool, dry place

Daily ration to be given to a 500 kg horse

All of the proposed rations must be related to the horse's state (health, age, condition), the intensity of physical activity and the nutritive quality of the forage or grazing available.
